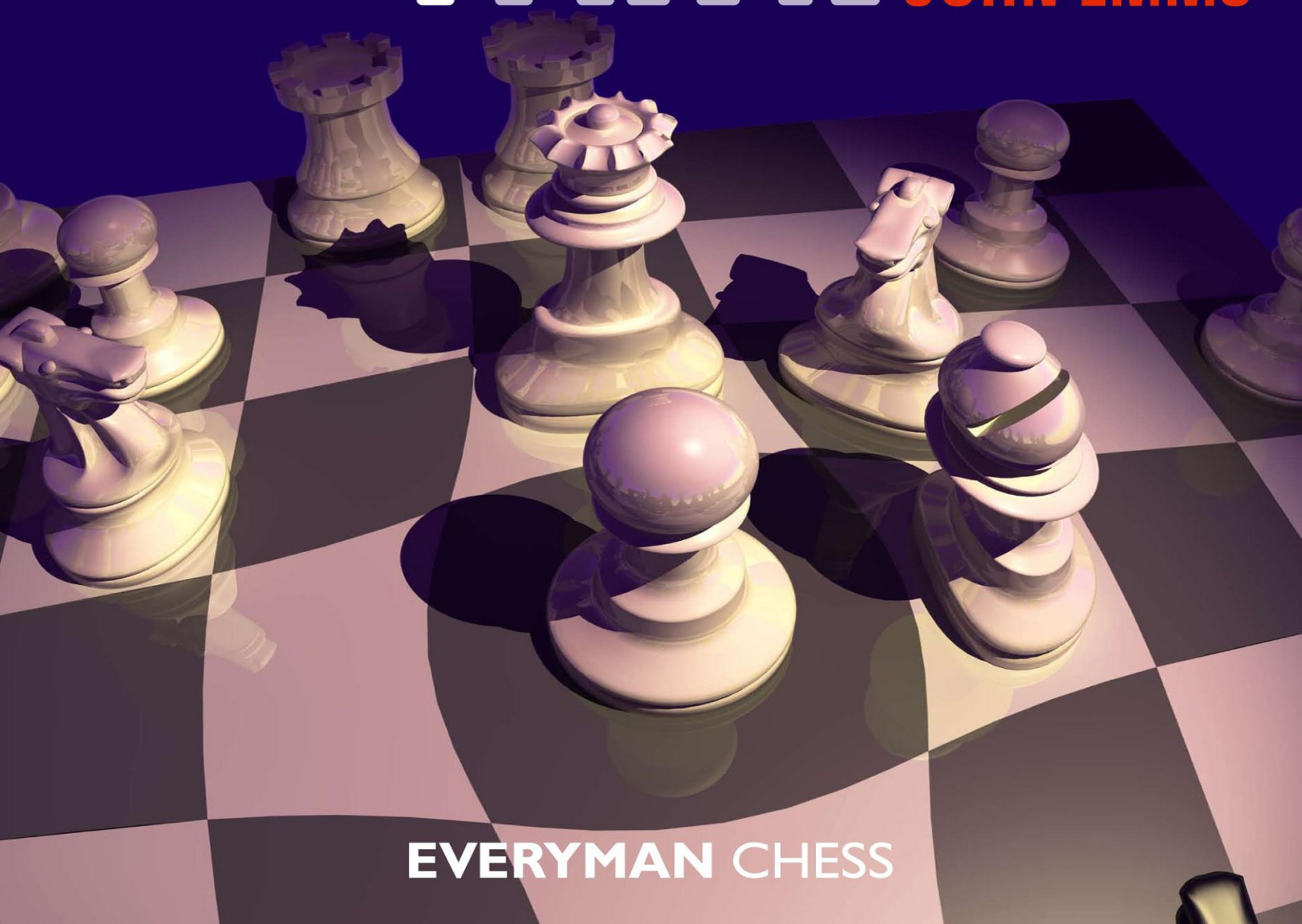

Love them or hate them, these positions are very difficult to avoid, so you really need to know what to do when you get them. In this book, John Emms examines the key tactical and positional ideas in IQP positions, with an emphasis on how to attack and how to defend.

In addition, he also explores openings which lead to IQPs, and suggests repertoire options which make sure you reach the positions you desire."
